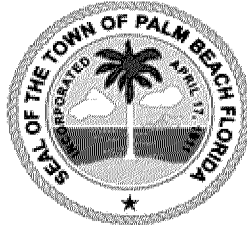

PROCEDURES FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Citizens desiring to address the Commission should proceed toward the public microphones when the applicable agenda item is being considered to enable the Chair to acknowledge you.

PUBLIC HEARINGS: Any citizen is entitled to be heard on an official agenda item under the section entitled "Public Hearings," subject to the three minute limitation.

COMMUNICATIONS FROM CITIZENS: Any citizen is entitled to be heard concerning any matter under the section entitled "Communications from Citizens," subject to the three minute limitation. The public also has the opportunity to speak to any item listed on the agenda, including the consent agenda, at the time the agenda item comes up for discussion.

OTHER AGENDA ITEMS: Any citizen is entitled to be heard on any official agenda item when the Commission calls for public comments, subject to the three minute limitation.

Planning and Zoning Commission are public business meetings and, as such, the Commission retains the right to limit discussion on any issue.
