STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Town Council approve Resolution No. 013-2021, declaring the results of the January 12, 2021 Town of Palm Beach Caucus and calling for election of March 9, 2021.

GENERAL INFORMATION

On January 12, 2021, the Town of Palm Beach held its 109th Town Caucus for the purpose of nominating candidates for the Offices of Mayor and Town Council Groups 1 and 2. There being only one nomination for Mayor, candidate Danielle Hickox Moore was declared unopposed and to be elected to the office of Mayor, effective as of the date of the general election, March 9, 2021. There being only one nomination for Council Member Group 2, candidate Julie Araskog, was declared unopposed and to be elected to the Office of Town Council Member Group 2, effective as of the date of the general election, March 9, 2021. Two nominations were received for Council Member Group 1, those being Candace Rojas and Edward “Ted Cooney. Their nominations being shown by the certified copy of the Minutes of said Caucus, which said certified copy is made a part of this Resolution.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE TOWN CAUCUS; DIRECTING THE TOWN CLERK OF SAID TOWN TO PLACE THE NAMES OF CERTAIN CANDIDATES ON THE OFFICIAL BALLOT FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN SAID TOWN ON THE NINTH DAY OF MARCH 2021; ADOPTING THE OFFICIAL BALLOT TO BE USED IN SAID ELECTION; AUTHORIZING THE TOWN CLERK TO ARRANGE FOR VOTING EQUIPMENT TO BE USED IN SAID ELECTION; AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR OF SAID TOWN TO ISSUE A PROCLAMATION OF SAID ELECTION, NAMING THEREIN THE CANDIDATES NOMINATED AND NAMED IN THE RESOLUTION; AND, DESIGNATING THE TOWN CLERK AND DEPUTY TOWN CLERK OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH AND THE SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, OR THEIR DESIGNEES, TO SERVE AS THE CANVASSING BOARD.

WHEREAS, at a regular and duly called Caucus of the Town of Palm Beach, Florida, held on January 12, 2021, the following persons were duly nominated at said Caucus by the voters of the Town of Palm Beach for the offices of Mayor and two Town Council Persons of said Town of Palm Beach, Florida, with the term of office for Mayor and Town Council Persons Groups One, and Group Two, to be for two-year periods, terms ending in March 2023:

SECTION ONE: It is hereby declared that the following candidates have been nominated and qualified for election to the seats for Mayor and for Town Council Persons in Groups One, Two and Mayor, each for a two-year period:

SECTION TWO: It is hereby declared that Danielle Hickox Moore, having no opposition for election, is hereby declared to be elected as Mayor of the Town of Palm Beach, effective as of the date of the general election, March 9, 2021.

SECTION THREE: It is hereby declared that Julie Araskog, having no opposition for election, is hereby declared to be elected as Town Council Person in Group Two, effective as of the date of the general election, March 9, 2021.

SECTION FOUR: The Town Clerk is hereby directed to have official ballots prepared for said election, and have printed thereon the names of the persons nominated for Town Council person in Group One for a term of two years. Since the candidate for Mayor and for Town Council Group Two had no opposition, the official ballot to be used in said election is substantially as follows, to wit:

SECTION NINE: The Mayor of the Town of Palm Beach is hereby required to issue her Proclamation of said Election and the date thereof to wit: March 9, 2021, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The names of the candidates proposed for office in said election shall be included in such Proclamation, which shall be printed in the Palm Beach Post on January 20, 2021, and in La Guia on January 22, 2021. The Town Clerk shall also post a copy of said Proclamation on the bulletin board in Town Hall.

SECTION TEN: The Town of Palm Beach Town Clerk, Queenester Nieves, or her designee, the Town of Palm Beach Deputy Town Clerk Pat Gayle-Gordon, or her designee, and the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, Wendy Sartory Link, or her designee, are hereby designated as the Town of Palm Beach Canvassing Board to carry out the duties, as prescribed in the Florida Statutes, for absentee ballots, the testing of the tabulating equipment, and to supervise the canvassing of the returns of the election, as prescribed by law.

MINUTES OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH TOWN CAUCUS HELD ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2021

A CAUCUS OF THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH WAS HELD VIA ZOOM, PALM BEACH, FLORIDA, AT 7:00 P.M. ON JANUARY 12, 2021, FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING CANDIDATES TOWN COUNCIL SEATS, GROUPS ONE, TWO and MAYOR.

The 109th Annual Town Caucus was held via zoom, at the above named time pursuant to the call and notice thereof, which was published in the Palm Beach Post, a newspaper in Palm Beach County, Florida, on December 21, 2020, December 28, 2020 and January 4, 2021, and in La Guia News, a Spanish language newspaper in Palm Beach County, Florida, on December 18, 2020, December 25, 2020 and January 1, 2021.

I. CALL TO ORDER – MAYOR GAIL CONIGLIO

The Caucus was called to order by Mayor Gail Coniglio.

II. ELECTION OF CAUCUS OFFICERS

Mayor Coniglio advised that the first order of business of this 109th Caucus was to elect Caucus Officers, consisting of a Caucus Chairperson and a Caucus Secretary. She stated that, pursuant to the Town Charter and Town Code, only qualified voters may participate in the Town Caucus, and that each nominator must state his or her name and street address.

A. Caucus Chairperson

On motion of Martin I. Klein, 1060 N. Ocean Blvd., Palm Beach, FL 33480, the nomination of Sue Patterson of 710 South Ocean Blvd, Palm Beach, FL 33480 for the 109th Town of Palm Beach Caucus Chairperson was made. Mayor Coniglio called for further nominations. There were none. Ms. Patterson was elected unanimously, by acclamation.

Ms. Patterson assumed the office of Chairperson, and called for nominations for a Caucus Secretary. Chair Patterson reminded all that pursuant to the Town Charter and Code, only

qualified voters of the Town are permitted to participate in this 109th Caucus. Each nominator must state his or her name and address.

B. Caucus Secretary

On motion of Martin I. Klein, 1060 N. Ocean Blvd., Palm Beach, FL 33480, the nomination of Nicki McDonald, 234 Merrain Road, Palm Beach, FL 33480, for Caucus Secretary was made. There being no further nominations, Ms. McDonald was elected unanimously, by acclamation.

III. NOMINATIONS FOR THE OFFICE OF TOWN COUNCIL MEMBER-GROUP ONE

Chair Patterson called for nominations for Town Council Member-Group One, the seat currently held by Danielle H. Moore. She announced that each nominator must state the name and street address of the person being nominated, as well as his or her own name and street address.

Cynthia Tindell, 2660 S. Ocean Blvd., #705-S, nominated Candace A. Rojas, 184 Sunset Avenue #25, as a candidate for Town Council Member-Group One.

The nomination was seconded by Debra Tomarin, 350 S. County Road #10, Palm Beach, FL 33480, and Daniel J. Franzese, 3140 S. Ocean Blvd., Apt 207-S, Palm Beach, FL 33480.

Chair Patterson called for further nominations.

Mary Brittain Damgard, 117 Wells Road, nominated Edward Ted Cooney 251 Royal Poinciana Way, #A as a candidate for Town Council Member-Group One.

The nomination was seconded by Abram Majtlis, 2275 South Ocean Blvd., #207A, Palm Beach, FL 33480, and John F. Cooney, 140 Seagate Road, Palm Beach, FL 33480.

After a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously passed to close nominations, Chair Patterson declared that nominations for candidates for Town Council Member-Group One were closed.

Chair Patterson then declared that Candace Rojas and Edward “Ted” Cooney have been duly nominated at the Town Caucus to be a candidates for the Office of Town Council Member-Group One, and requested that the candidates state their address and that they are registered voters in the Town of Palm Beach.

Candace A. Rojas, was recognized and stated she was a registered voter and her address is 184 Sunset Avenue #25, Palm Beach, FL 33480. She stated that she was pleased to be here, along with her team.

Edward Ted” Cooney, was recognized and stated he was a registered voter and his address is 251 Royal Poinciana Way, #A, Palm Beach, FL 33480. He honored Gail Coniglio and the Town Staff.

IV. NOMINATIONS FOR THE OFFICE OF TOWN COUNCIL MEMBER-GROUP TWO

Chair Patterson called for nominations for Town Council Member-Group Two, the seat currently held by Julie Araskog. She announced that each nominator must state the name and street address of the person being nominated, as well as his or her own name and street address.

Margaret Moore, 221 El Bravo Way, nominated Julie Araskog, 1490 Via Manana, as a candidate for Town Council Member-Group Two.

The nomination was seconded by, Martin Klein 1060 North Ocean Blvd., Robert Wildrick, 220 Nightingale Trail, and Gail Ellen Howe, 2295 South Ocean Blvd., PH 20, Palm Beach, FL 33480.

Chair Patterson called for further nominations for Town Council Member-Group Two and there were none.

After a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously passed to close nominations, Chair Patterson declared that nominations for Town Council Member-Group two, were closed.

Chair Patterson then declared that Julie Araskog has been nominated at the 109th Town Caucus to be a candidate for the Office of Town Council Member-Group Two, and requested that the candidate state her name and address.

Julie Araskog was recognized. She states that she is a registered voter and that her address is 1490 Via Manana, Palm Beach, FL 33480, and that she was humbled and honored to serve the Town of Palm Beach for the past four years.

V. NOMINATIONS FOR THE OFFICE OF TOWN MAYOR

Chairman Patterson called for nominations for Town Mayor, the seat currently held by Gail Coniglio. She announced that each nominator must state the name and street address of the person being nominated, as well as his or her own name and street address.

Michael J. Pucillo, 224 Dunbar Road, Palm Beach, FL 33480 nominated Danielle H. Moore, 227 Pendleton Avenue, Palm Beach, FL 33480, as a candidate for Mayor for the Town of Palm Beach.

The nomination was seconded by Alfred P. Aldridge III, 2295 South Ocean Blvd., #701, Palm Beach, FL 33480, and Carla Termini, 2860 South Ocean Blvd., #305, Palm Beach, FL 33480.

Chair Patterson called for further nominations for Town Mayor there were none.

After a motion was made, seconded, and unanimously passed to close nominations, Chair Patterson declared that nominations for Town Mayor were closed.

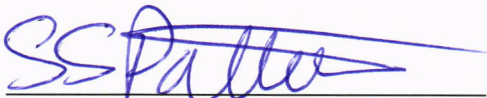

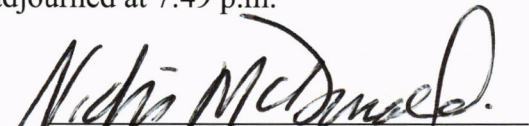

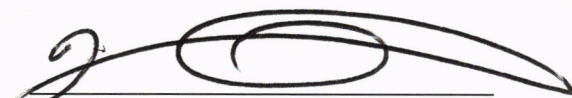
