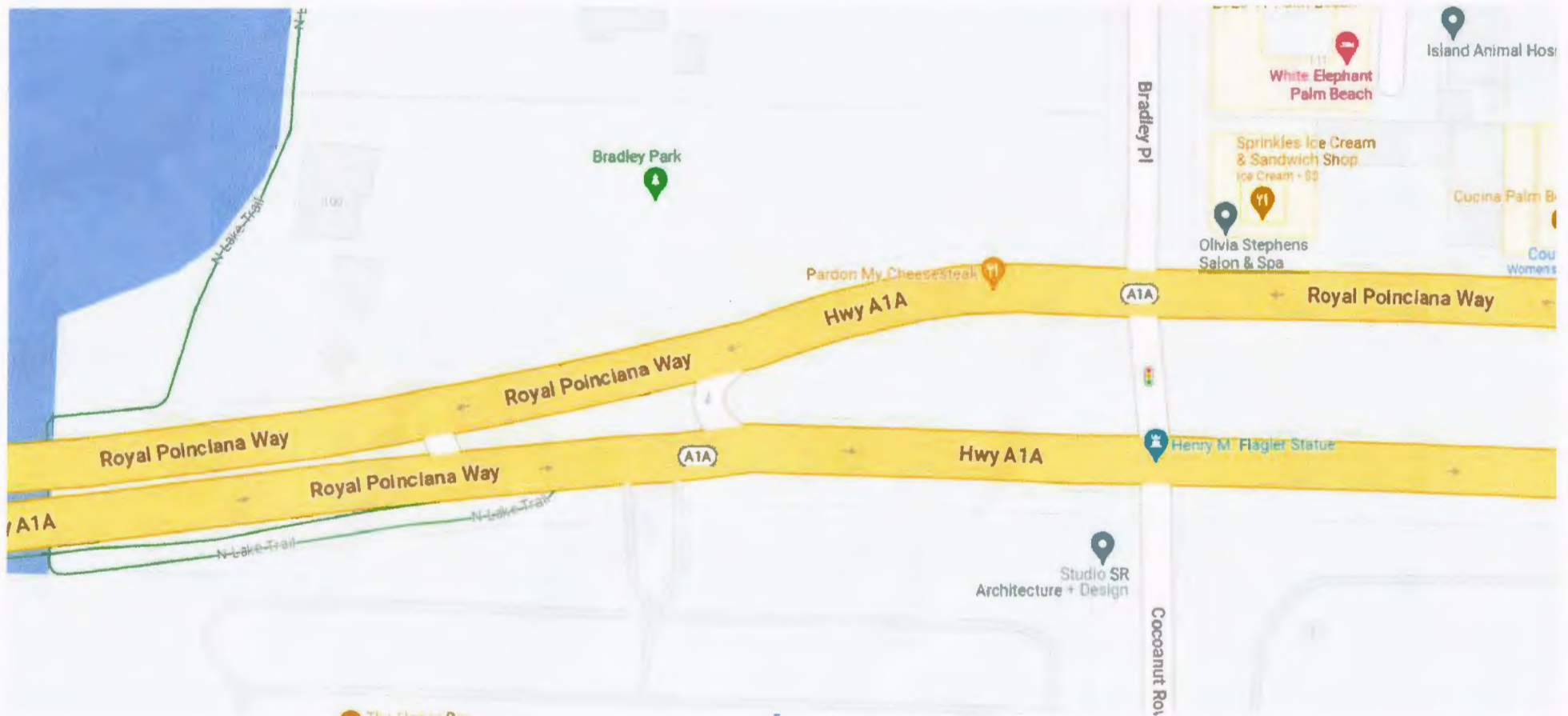

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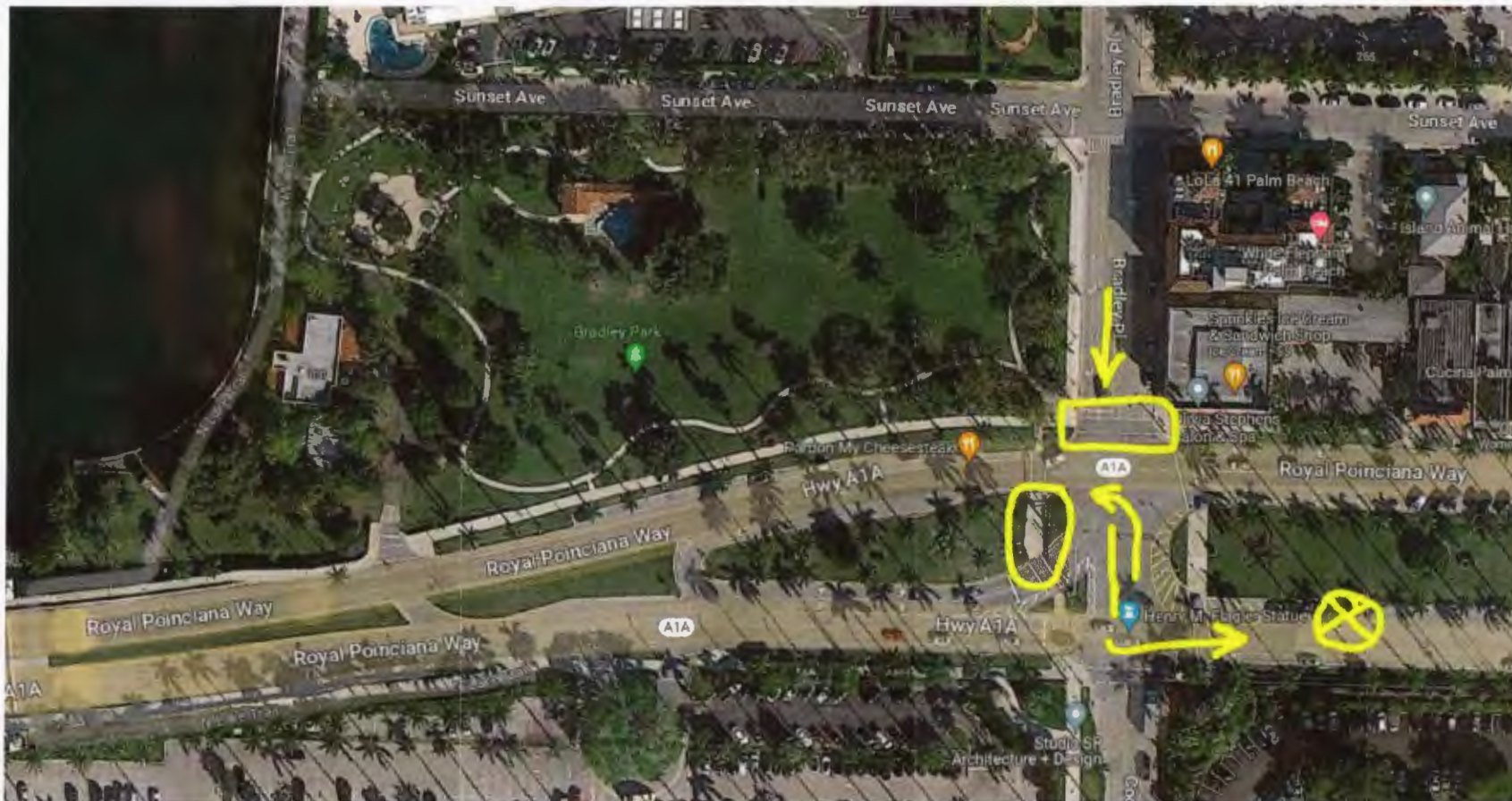

Traffic Pattern Change – Sunset Avenue & Bradley Place

The Palm Beach Police Department is alerting residents to an upcoming traffic pattern change at the intersection of Sunset Avenue and Bradley Place on Tuesday, 4/25/2023. Effective on that date, Westbound traffic in the 200 block of Sunset Avenue will only be able to make a right turn onto Northbound Bradley Place. This change is being made to assist with congestion in the area of that intersection. The Police Department will be observing the change, educating drivers, and monitoring the effectiveness.

Traffic alert: Pattern to change at Sunset Avenue and Bradley Place in Palm Beach

The departure of some seasonal residents might be alleviating traffic on the island a bit, but the town is still taking measures to help ease bottlenecks at certain spots.

Starting Tuesday, the traffic pattern at Sunset Avenue and Bradley Place will be adjusted to help with congestion at that intersection. Westbound vehicles in the 200 block of Sunset Avenue will be able to make only a right turn onto northbound Bradley Place, the Palm Beach Police Department said in a release Friday.

The department said it will be ob-

serving the change, educating drivers, and monitoring the effectiveness of the new pattern.

Against the background of growing complaints from residents, the Town Council in February hired a Miami-based consultant to conduct a comprehensive traffic engineering and parking study of the town.

As part of the study, The Corradino Group will review the traffic impact of existing restaurants in the town's commercial area, evaluate the existing parking supply in the commercial area, and review the origin and destination of the traffic traveling into the commercial area on a daily basis.
