3. **174-2025** A Resolution Of The Town Council Of The Town Of Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, Declaring The Results Of The Town Caucus; Directing The Town Clerk Of Said Town To Place The Names Of Certain Candidates On The Official Ballot For The General Election To Be Held In Said Town On The Tenth Day Of March 2026; Adopting The Official Ballot To Be Used In Said Election; Authorizing The Town Clerk To Arrange For Voting Equipment To Be Used In Said Election; And Directing The Mayor Of Said Town To Issue A Proclamation Of Said Election, Naming Therein The Candidates Nominated And Named In The Resolution; And, Designating The Supervisor Of Elections Of Palm Beach County, or Designees, To Serve As The Canvassing Board.

Council President Lindsay read Resolution No. 174-2025 by title.

A motion was made by Council President Pro Tem Crampton and seconded by Council Member Araskog to approve Resolution No. 174-2025. The motion was carried unanimously, 4-0.

4. Mayor's Proclamation to the Qualified Electors of the Town of Palm Beach Regarding the Town Election of March 10, 2026

Mayor Moore read the Proclamation declaring a general election in the Town of Palm Beach on March 10, 2026, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing one Town Council member for Group 1 for a two-year period. The candidates' names for the ballot will be John David Corey and Lewis "Lew" S.W. Crampton. The names of the precincts and polling locations were announced.

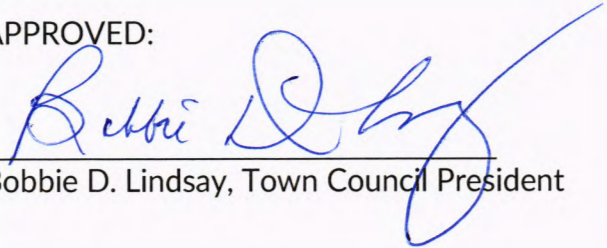
ANY OTHER BUSINESS

ADJOURNMENT

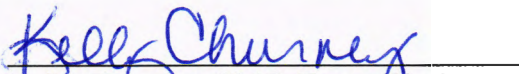
