SEAVIEW PARK COMMISSION MEETING

NOVEMBER 18, 1998

- I. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL - A meeting of the Seaview Park Commission was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Gavigan at 1:10 on November 18, 1998, at the Palm Beach Recreation Center. The Commission members in attendance were Mr. Gavigan, Mrs. Coniglio, Mrs. Drake, Mrs. Morris, Mrs. Fisher and Mr. Silken. Absent from the meeting was Mr. Morton Shor and alternate members Mr. Turchan and Mr. Spaziani. Staff members in attendance were Mr. Bitzer, Mrs. Stone, and Mrs. Walkowich. Also in attendance was Mr. Arthur Gross of the Golf Commission.
- II. APPROVAL OF AGENDA - Mr. Gavigan asked for an approval of the agenda. Mrs. Morris made the motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Mrs. Fisher, all were in favor.
- III. APPROVAL OF SEPTEMBER 23, 1998, MINUTES - Mr. Gavigan asked for an approval of the September 23, 1998, minutes. Mrs. Morris made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Mrs. Fisher, all were in favor.
- IV. OLD BUSINESS

A. Update on Proposed Merger of the Seaview Park & Golf Commission

Mr. Bitzer said that the Ordinance Rules and Standards Committee had met, reviewed the draft ordinance and forwarded the draft ordinance to the Town Council for a first reading at their December meeting. (A copy of the draft ordinance was distributed to the commission members.)

After a review of the draft ordinance and a discussion of what had occurred at the ORS meeting, the Seaview Park Commission decided to let their original vote stand which was; that as long as there was equal representation of the program areas on the new commission that they would not be opposed to the merging of the two commissions.

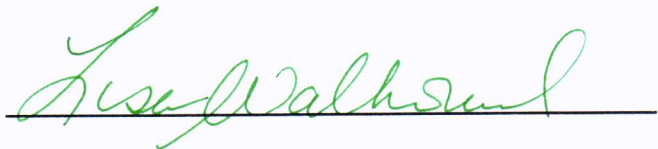

Youth programs are in the 9th week of the 12 week session. Classes are going very well and overall enrollment has increased.

Three new preschool classes have been added for the winter session: Kindermusik Village, Kindermusik Beginnings, and Kindermusik Growings.

Adult programs began the week of November 2, 1998. Four new adult programs have been added for the winter session: Writing to Publish, Meditation, Stress Management, and Line Dancing

Two craft parties for children ages 3-8 remain for Fall: Turkeys and Treats, Saturday, November 21, 1:00-2:30 p.m. and Winter Wonderland on Saturday, December 9 from 3:30-5:00 p.m.
