

Town of Palm Beach
Golf Commission Meeting
November 5, 1993

A meeting of the Palm Beach Golf Commission was held at 9:00 a.m. on November 5, 1993 at the Town Hall. Present were Commissioners Keresey, Pollock, Berkow, Clark, Herman, and Levy, and staff Rick Dytrych, Brenda Joyce, and Stephanie.

Ann Herman discussed the comments of the Town Council regarding the Par 3 Tournament. A permit is required for charity, and although there were several other possibilities, the Council concluded that the area hospitals have been the least controversial.

The date for the tournament was set for Thursday, January 27th, with Friday, January 28th, set for the rain date.

A discussion of building captains was held with attempt to obtain volunteers at the various condo buildings.

The tournament overall costs are estimated to be \$18,000.

Discussions regarding the course included the Joe Lee meetings over the summer with the focus being the greens. Lee will do the project for \$7,500, of which \$4,000 of drawings and plans are already completed. The overall project cost is estimated at \$225,000, of which \$170,000 will be dedicated to green improvement. 16 tees will also be improved, plus some drainage work.

It is recommended to the Recreation Department that the Council and Town management consider the project. The reserve cash position does have excess cash for the project.

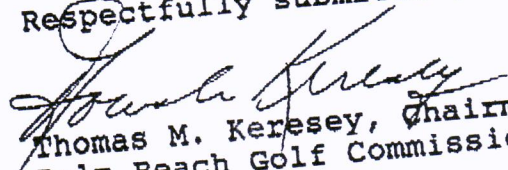
The Commission recommends that the course be closed for the period of June through August 1994 to rebuild all 18 holes at once. A consideration of 9 and 9 over two years was discussed, but the aggravation and the mess of 9 holes under construction all speak to doing it at once. It has been 14 years since the holes were rebuilt.

Renaldo is retiring at the end of the year. Staff will participate in the rebuilding project.

It is recommended that caution signs be improved with the golf car sign. It will be researched and we will be advised.

With there being no further business, the Commission adjourned at 9:50 a.m. The next meeting is scheduled for Friday, December 3rd, at Town Hall.
