The first Fall meeting of the Town of Palm Beach Golf Commission was held at the Town Hall 3rd floor conference room, Friday, October 26, 1990.

Present at the meeting were Chairman Thomas M. Keresey, Commissioner Ash Clark, Pro/Manager Rick Dytrych, and as guest, Ralph Hodson of Trust National.

Mr. Keresey called the meeting to order at 9:10 a.m.

The minutes of the last Spring meeting held on May 14th were reviewed and approved.

The 8th Annual Hospital Pro-Am LPGA was discussed and the date of Monday, February 11, 1991. A rain date of Friday, February 12th was recommended.

The Commission requests that at the Town Council meeting scheduled for November 13th, the Council grant the Commission permission for a Charitable Solicitation Permit. All net proceeds will again be distributed to the three area hospitals.

The Commission received and accepted with regret the resignation of Mr. Irving Kaufman for health reasons.

Mr. Dytrych discussed the:

- Preliminary plans for the 8th Pro-Am
- Entry fee/player was increased to \$250, up for the first time in three years, from the previous \$200
- Hole sponsors will be recognized at \$500/hole
- Spectator tickets will remain at \$10
- Palm Beach Civic Association will include a notice of the Pro-Am event in its November letter to members
- Palm Beach Chamber will have Rick at their December meeting to publicize the Pro-Am, to be arranged by Ralph Hodson.
- A possible new golf commissioner candidate was discussed.

Mr. Dytrych reviewed the current condition of the Par 3 golf course:

- The new maintenance building is open and operating.
- The expanded practice putting green will be open shortly.
- The driving range was expanded over the summer.
- Staff is in place for the start of the winter season.
- Joan retired after 29 years and has been replaced.

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Gross revenues for the just completed fiscal year were \$697M versus \$636M for 1989.

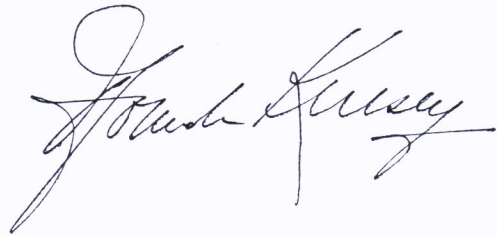
New additional plants and an upgraded irrigation system have been installed.
