Golf Commission Meeting
March 19, 1993

A meeting of the Palm Beach Golf Commission was held at the golf course on March 19, 1993. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. and present were Commissioners Keresey, Knopf, Berkow, Pollock, and town representatives Russ Bitzer, Rick Dytrych, and Brenda.

An unofficial meeting of some Commissioners was held March 5th to discuss the LPGA donation presentation for the Hurricane Andrew "We Will Rebuild" organization.

The minutes of the February 5th meeting were formally approved.

Brenda reviewed the March 9th presentation at the Town Council meeting. Mr. Clark was complimented on his "professional" presentation.

The new pump station has started operating. It will probably need a block housecover.

February financial results were reviewed and were considered very positive.

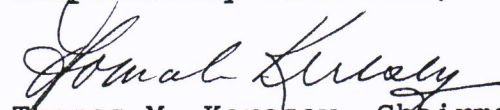
The storm on March 12th caused fence damage to the trees and the driving range fence.

The proposed rate increases for summer 1993 were reviewed. This would be the normal period (2 years) for a reasonable increase. We will keep the average price competitive with other summer rates. Mr. Berkow questioned the need in consideration of the players. In addition, the Town has approved the Par 3's participation in the Value Book to play on a one time \$5 fee. The Commissioners approved the modest summer rate increases.

Expansion of the Golf Commission will go into the Council for a second reading at the April meeting. The Town Council may also appoint additional alternates at their pleasure.

The meeting was concluded and adjourned at 9:30 a.m. The next meeting of the Commission was scheduled for April 30th at 9:00 a.m. at the golf course.
