Golf Commission Meeting
February 5, 1993

A scheduled meeting of the Town's Golf Commission was held in the Town Hall chambers at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, February 5, 1993. Present were Commissioners Keresey, Clark, Berkow, Pollock and course employee Brenda.

Minutes were distributed and approved. Brenda reviewed the financial results of the LPGA tournament. Overall, without a corporate underwriter, \$15,531 net of expenses was raised for Hurricane Andrew's "We Will Rebuild".

Minutes to reflect the excellent results from the Town employees, particularly Rick, Brenda, Renalda, and Austin.

The sale of spectator tickets could be improved. Key is the captain under control of the ticket sales. A local charity would probably be a stronger draw.

We will arrange the donation with particular emphasis on Andrew. Joe April is the director of "We Will Rebuild". Suggestion of presentation at the Town Council's March 9th meeting.

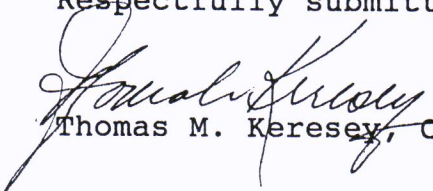

Early February has been very positive. As an example, 265 players plus 180 range buckets on February 4th.
