

MINUTES OF THE TOWN CAUCUS HELD ON JANUARY 3, 1995

A CAUCUS OF THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF PALM BEACH WAS HELD IN THE TOWN HALL COUNCIL CHAMBERS, PALM BEACH, FLORIDA, AT 8:00 P.M. ON JANUARY 3, 1995, FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING CANDIDATES FOR MAYOR FOR A TWO YEAR TERM; ONE TOWN COUNCIL SEAT IN GROUP ONE FOR A ONE YEAR TERM AND TWO COUNCIL SEATS IN GROUPS TWO AND THREE FOR TWO YEAR TERMS.

A caucus of the voters of the Town of Palm Beach was held in the Town Council Chambers at the above named time pursuant to the call and notice therefore, which call had been published in the Palm Beach Daily News, a newspaper in Palm Beach County, Florida, on the following named dates: December 19, 1994; December 26, 1994, and January 2, 1995.

The Caucus was called to order by Mayor Paul R. Ilyinsky who stated its object and advised of other required procedures of candidates who would be nominated this date. Mayor Ilyinsky advised that the first order of business of this 83rd Caucus was to elect Caucus Officers, consisting of a Caucus Chairman and a Caucus Secretary. Pursuant to the Town Code, only qualified voters may participate in the Town Caucus. Each nominator must state his/her name and street address.

Mayor Ilyinsky stated the Town Clerk, Grace Peters, and Mary Pollitt, Deputy Town Clerk, would assist the Secretary in the handling of her duties and further reminded all candidates in order to meet the qualifications for office as set out in the Town of Palm Beach Code of Ordinances and Florida State Statutes, they needed to contact the Office of the Town Clerk to pick up the necessary information.

On motion of Bruce McAllister, 1085 North Lake Way, the nomination of William J. Brooks, 240 Seabreeze Avenue, for Caucus Chairman was made. There were no further nominations, and Mr. William J. Brooks was elected as Chairman of the 83rd Caucus and assumed the duties of his office.

Chairman Brooks called for nominations for a Caucus Secretary. Chairman Brooks reminded all that pursuant to the Town Charter and Code, only qualified voters or electors of the Town are permitted to participate in this 83rd Caucus. Each nominator must state his/her name and address. Elise McIntosh, 315 South Lake Drive, nominated for Caucus Secretary Elizabeth Bryant, 145 Seaspray Avenue. There were no further nominations and Mrs. Bryant was declared the 83rd Caucus Secretary.

Chairman Brooks stated Mrs. Grace T. Peters, Town Clerk, and Mrs. Mary A. Pollitt, Deputy Town Clerk, will assist the Caucus Secretary, Betty Bryant.

Chairman Brooks said the meeting was open for the purpose of nominating candidates who are qualified Town voters to serve in the office of Mayor, the Office now held by Mayor Paul R. Ilyinsky, which is a two year term to be voted at the general election to be held on Tuesday, February 7, 1995. The nomination, to be valid, must be made by a Town voter and must receive two seconds, each seconder being a Town voter. Each nominator and seconder must state his/her name and street address.

Mr. Herbert Swope, 777 South County Road, nominated Paul R. Ilyinsky, 270 Algoma Road, for the Office of Mayor. Mr. Ilyinsky's nomination was seconded by Mr. John Matich, 3475 South Ocean Boulevard and Col. I. Henry Stern, 2840 South Ocean Boulevard. Chairman Brooks called for further nominations and there were none.

Chairman Brooks announced the candidate for the Office of Mayor is:

Paul R. Ilyinsky
270 Algoma

He asked Mayor Ilyinsky to stand and be recognized.

Chairman Brooks then called for nominations for the Town Council Seat for Group One, previously held by the late M. William Weinberg. The office currently is held by C. Gerald Goldsmith. The office is for a one year term, the balance of Councilman Weinberg's two-year term, to be voted at the general election to be held on February 7, 1995.

Mr. Charles Bane, Jr., 440 Brazilian Avenue, nominated Sandra Goldberg, 2000 South Ocean Boulevard, as a candidate for Group One. The nomination was seconded by Barbara Gordon Green, 583 North Lake Way, and William Y. Matheson, 22 Sloan's Curve Drive.

Chairman Brooks called for further nominations and Isadore S. Segall, 2660 South Ocean Boulevard, placed in nomination the name of John (Jack) L. McDonald, 2170 Ibis Isle Road. The nomination was seconded by Rita Taca, 2000 South Ocean Boulevard, and Leon G. Schwartz, 3440 South Ocean Boulevard.

Chairman Brooks called for further nominations and there were none, and he announced the nominations were closed for Group One.

Chairman Brooks announced the candidates for Group One are:

Sandra Goldberg
Jack L. McDonald

Both candidates stood and were recognized.

Chairman Brooks then called for nominations for the Town Council Seat for Group Two, for a two year term, which was previously held by Councilwoman Hermine L. Wiener.

Doyle Rogers, 1435 South Ocean Boulevard, placed in nomination the name of Allen Wyett, 1145 North Lake Way, for a candidate in Group Two. The nomination was seconded by Marvin Rosenberg, 125 Chateaux Drive, and Mark R. Wolfson, 310 Polmer Park.

Chairman Brooks called for further nominations and George Slaton, 430 Australian Avenue, nominated Hermine L. Wiener of 324 Garden Road. The nomination was seconded by Dorothy Levy, 150

Bradley Place, Morton E. Shor, 2560 South Ocean Boulevard, and Patricia K. Tracy, 244 Nightingale Trail.

Chairman Brooks called for further nominations and there were none. He declared the nominations for Group Two Candidates were closed and announced the candidates in Group Two are:

Allen Wyett
Hermine L. Wiener

Each candidate stood and was recognized.

Chairman Brooks called for nominations of candidates to serve a two year term as a Town Council member in Group Three, which is currently held by Councilwoman Michele Clarke Royal.

Bernard R. (Robin) Baker, 127 Seaspray Avenue, placed in nomination the name of Michele Clarke Royal, 277 Pendleton Road. Ann K. Herman, 2778 South Ocean Boulevard, and Stuart Shulman, 2280 South Ocean Boulevard, seconded the nomination.

Chairman Brooks called for further nominations and Herbert Lee, 2 North Breakers Row, nominated Samuel C. McLendon, 300 South Ocean Boulevard, as a candidate for Group Three. The nomination was seconded by Sherry Lehr, 350 Cocoanut Row, and Alexander Beal, 1050 North Ocean Boulevard.

Chairman Brooks called for further nominations, and there were none. Chairman Brooks announced the nominations for Group Three were closed.

Chairman Brooks announced the candidates for Group Three were:

Michele Clarke Royal
Samuel C. McLendon

Each was asked to stand and be recognized.

There being no further business to come before the Caucus, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried, the Caucus meeting was adjourned. The Chairperson and the Secretary were authorized to present a Certificate of this 83rd Caucus to the Town Council at their meeting scheduled for January 17, 1995, 9:30 a.m., to call for the Election.
